- Recruitment
- Advertising
- Hiring
- Placement
- Promotion
- Transfer
- Training and Apprenticeship
- Compensation
- Termination or Layoff
- Physical Facilities
- Any other terms, conditions or privileges of employment

The Kentucky Civil Rights Act prohibits employment discrimination based on:

- Disability
- Race
- Color
- Religion
- National Origin
- Sex
- Age (40 Years. Old and Over)
- Tobacco-Smoking Status

The Kentucky Civil Rights Act prohibits employment discrimination by:

- Employers
- Labor Organizations
- Employment Agencies
- Licensing Agencies
